

# What goes into **what bin?**



## Green Bin

### Recyclables

- Paper
- Cardboard
- Food tins
- Drinks cans
- Tetra-Pak cartons (e.g. milk, soup and juice cartons)
- Hard plastics (e.g. mineral, water and detergent bottles PET1, HDPE2, PP)
- Soft plastics (e.g. crisp packets, plastics bag and wrapping, bubble wrap)

**All must be clean and dry.**



## Brown Bin

### Organics

- Coffee grounds & filters
- Cooked & raw foods
- Dairy products
- Eggs & egg shells
- Fruit, vegetables & peelings
- Tea leaves & tea bags
- Meat, bones & fish
- Hedge clippings, twigs & branches (max. 2 inches in diameter)
- Leaves, plants, weeds & grass



## Black Bin

### General waste

- Nappies
- Soiled food packaging
- Bathroom waste
- Animal waste
- Aerosols
- Cold ashes
- Fast food cup lids
- Used candles

## Not allowed in any bin

Certain items need to be disposed of at a civic amenity. If these items are found in your bin, the bin will be marked as contaminated and may not be collected. For more, please see our T&C's at [greyhound.ie](http://greyhound.ie)
