Recyclables

Paper

Cardboard

Food tins

Drinks cans

Tetra-Pak cartons (e.g. milk, soup and juice cartons)

Hard plastics (e.g. mineral, water and detergent bottles PET1, HDPE2, PP) Soft plastics (e.g. crisp packets, plastics bag and wrapping, bubble wrap)

All must be clean and dry.

Brown Bin

Organics

Cooked & raw foods
Dairy products
Eggs & egg shells
Fruit, vegatables & peelings
Tea leaves & tea bags
Meat, bones & fish
Hedge clippings, twigs & branches (max. 2 inches in diameter)
Leaves, plants, weeds & grass



Black Bin

General waste

Nappies
Soiled food packaging
Bathroom waste
Animal waste
Aerosols
Cold ashes
Fast food cup lids
Used candles

Not allowed in any bin

Certain items need to be disposed of at a civic amenity. If these items are found in your bin, the bin will be marked as contaminated and may not be collected. For more, please see our T&C's at greyhound.ie

Builders rubble
Bricks
Batteries
Electrical items
Metal

Oil & liquids
Paint
Harzardous waste
