- Conduct regular inspections to ensure all vehicles comply with legal and safety regulations.
- Maintain accurate records of all work performed, including inspections, repairs, and parts used, in line with company policies and legal requirements.
- Work closely with the workshop team and third-party contractors to prioritise workloads and ensure minimal downtime for vehicles.
- Attend to roadside vehicle breakdowns when required.
